



1a.4 Extremism – the Prevent Duty Policy & Procedure

Policy Statement:

Under the Counter-Terrorism and Security Act 2015 we have a duty to refer any concerns of extremism to the police. FDNM commit to ensuring we partake in all precautions stated in this legislation.

Procedure:

In the event that any member of staff at FDNM has concerns relating to extremism, they must speak to the manager at their earliest convenience.

This may be a cause for concern relating to a change in behaviour of a child or family member, comments causing concern made to a member of the team (or other persons in the setting) or actions that lead staff to be worried about the safety of a child in their care.
